The Abstract submission deadline is October 14, 2020.

Abstracts

Abstracts should be concise and be able to appropriately describe your research within a **1-page limit**. The title is limited to **300 characters** and the body (including Title, Authors, and Affiliations) is limited to a single page with at least 1-inch margins. You may use any standard font (11 pt or larger).

Guidelines for preparing your poster

You can create your poster using PowerPoint, Adobe Illustrator, Canvas, or any other appropriate program. The poster must be one page and in English. All posters must be submitted in PDF format.
